In celebration, a snack of popcorn and juice was shared. "Wow! This is nice," Molinaro told the students. "I don't get popcorn where I work." After being asked by a student for a "small autograph," Molinaro signed copies of "Oh the Places You'll Go" to commemorate his visit.
